Directions by Metro

1. Take the Metro to the **Capitol South** Station.
2. As a single exit metro station, take the escalator up to the ground level. ○
3. Keep walking straight ahead from the metro escalator uphill along First Street SE.
4. After 1 full block, cross right across First Street along Independence Avenue.
5. When the crosswalk permits, cross left across Independence Avenue.
6. The Jefferson Building of the Library of Congress is ahead on the right.
7. The main general entrance steps are on the First Street side of the building. ☆
